Enhanced website tracks inventory in support of the Alberta COVID-19 Pharmacy Immunization Program (ACPIP)

Inventory tracking related to COVID-19 products and services found on the Alberta Blue Cross website is moving online. Pharmacies are still required to complete vaccine reconciliation activities in AVI.

Based on your feedback, we're excited to announce that, effective **February 16, 2022**, all pharmacies registered for the Pharmacy Provider Website can now submit inventory information related to available ACPIP products and services online. Simply visit our pharmacy provider site at <u>ab.bluecross.ca/provider/type/pharmacy/secure-online-site.php</u> any time to indicate the availability of

- · vaccines, such as Pfizer or Moderna; and
- · rapid take-home test kits.

You will also be able to remove your pharmacy from the list of participating ACPIP pharmacies on the Alberta Blue Cross website. Please note that we anticipate that inventory submissions will be published on our website every weekday afternoon.

For detailed information on how to change your inventory information, please reference pages 24 and 40 of our <u>user guide</u>.

This enhancement is in addition to functionality already available on our website, including the ability to

- · view your patient's compound history;
- · confirm compound eligibility for your patient with near real-time topical compound authorization results;
- view your pharmacy's previous compound authorizations;
- inquire on your patient's special authorization;
- · view your payment reports; and
- · change address and banking information (for independent pharmacies only).

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If you have not yet registered for our pharmacy provider website, please visit <u>ab.bluecross.ca/provider/type/pharmacy/secure-online-site.php</u> to access the user guide and register for an account. The website allows pharmacy owners to register for up to three accounts. Each account has varying levels of permission as noted below.
